### What's New in Architecture5

Architecture5 is a comprehensive plan for improving the NAS and reaching the Target System Description (TSD). The TSD is a view into the Architecture for the year 2015. TSD is based on the joint FAA and industry operational concept for planning and conducting flights with greater safety, flexibility, and efficiency.

The NAS interface view continues to evolve - systems and domains have been better separated on the initial interface.

10 new OI sequenced diagrams (example) were added under NAS Status Advisory and Traffic Advisory. They show how information flows between the systems that make up a particular Advisory.
